The 23th Annual Les Zimmerman Memorial Handicap Charity Golf Tournament, sponsored by the Ohio State Aerie, F.O.E., will be hosted by Lima #370. It will be held at Tamarac GC , and Lost Creek GC The dates for the two week-end tournament are Saturday and Sunday, July 26 & 27 ,and Saturday and Sunday, August 2, & 3, 2014.

The tournament will have a Championship Flight and six sub-flights. If you sign up for the handicap flight and shoot a 79 or lower, you will be put into the Championship Flight. This is to protect the handicap golfers. If you are a Championship golfer, please sign up as one. The handicap system will be the Callaway System with the committee to make the decision on what day to Callaway.

The entry fee is \$75.00 per person. It includes green fees and carts for 36 holes, trophies or plaques, cash prizes and golf balls for the long drive, pin shots and low putts. Plaques will be given to the first place winners in each flight.

ENTRIES WILL CLOSE ON MARCH 28, 2014 OR THE FIRST 1,000 ENTRIES.
